Review from Chicago Eater:

Roscoe Village received a culinary upgrade earlier this week when **Le Sud**, a new two-level restaurant, opened. Dishes on its Mediterranean French menu includes rabbit leg à la Provençal and a foie gras tart. It's a casual spot on the neighborhood's main drag at 2301 W. Roscoe Street.

Travels through southern France inspired owner Sandy Chen (Koi Fine Asian Dining in Evanston) to open the restaurant. She said southern French cuisine reminded her of the food served in her native Zhejiang, a province along China's east coast. She's charged executive chef Ryan Brosseau (Table, Donkey & Stick in Logan Square and the shuttered Perennial Virant in Lincoln Park) with creating a "Provençal inspired" menu. It includes pan-roasted duck and steak frites.
